

# Wheel of Fortune

---

This is another great Recall Activity you can apply to your lesson. However, there's no actual wheel involved, nor is there a runway models flipping letters, but fun just the same.

Needed (White Board and Markers)

Preparation:

- Find a word or phrase from your Lesson.
- Mark "underlines" on the whiteboard, each representing the letter of the word or phrase.
- Write the vowels on a separate line below (A, E, I, O and U).
- Divide boys into two Teams.
- Teams need to pick a captain. It makes it easier when one person on is designated spokesman (captain) for the team, otherwise it can get confusing. Instruct teams to decide together when they choose letters. The captain tells the RA Leader, which letter they have chosen.

To Play:

1. Team "A" picks ONE free vowel. If incorrect, just continue play. There is no penalty. (Both Teams do this each turn until all vowels are gone).
2. Now, Team A chooses ONE consonant. If incorrect, play go's to Team B. However, if they are correct, they are allowed to choose another consonant.
3. First team to solve wins.
4. TIP: Use Phrases or Bible Verses to make it more challenging.
